PUBLIC NOTICE

GENERAL PERMITS

SAJ-20, SAJ-33, SAJ-42

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: To simplify and speed evaluation of Department of the Army permit applications, the Jacksonville District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers promulgates Regional General Permits (general permits) to authorize a variety of minor activities. Each general permit is valid for a five-year period.

BACKGROUND: All of the general permits listed below have been reauthorized for a five-year period and are now due to expire on May 1, 2007:

SAJ-20 - Private Single-Family Piers in Florida

SAJ-33 - Private Multi-Family Piers - State of Florida

SAJ-42 - Riprap revetments; maintenance dredging in upland artificial residential canals; boat ramps; aerial transmission lines; subaqueous utility and transmission lines; boat slips; private single-family piers and appurtenances; stormwater outfalls; bulkheads and backfill in artificial canals; minor structures; and riprap placed under piers for mitigation as required by Miami-Dade County Department of Environmental Resource Management (DERM), in waters of the U.S. located within Miami-Dade County, Florida

The criteria specified in SAJ-20, SAJ-33 and SAJ-42, which are due to expire on June 1, 2002, are superseded by the criteria specified in the reauthorized versions of SAJ-20, SAJ-33 and SAJ-42. These reauthorized permits will expire on May 1, 2007. Existing authorizations under the prior versions of SAJ-20 or SAJ-33 will be valid until June 1, 2003.
